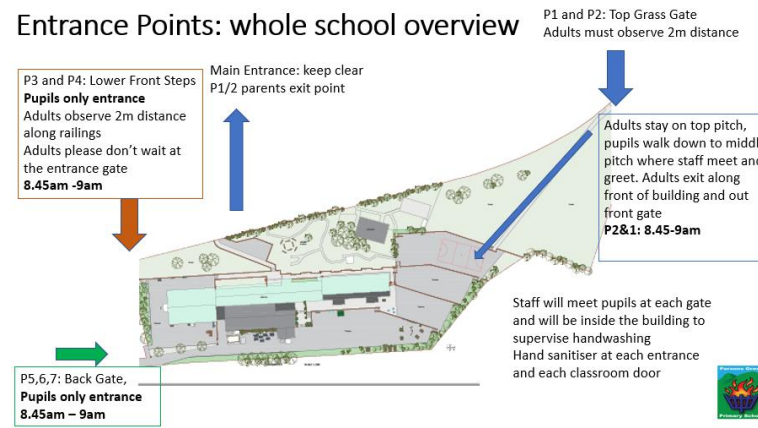

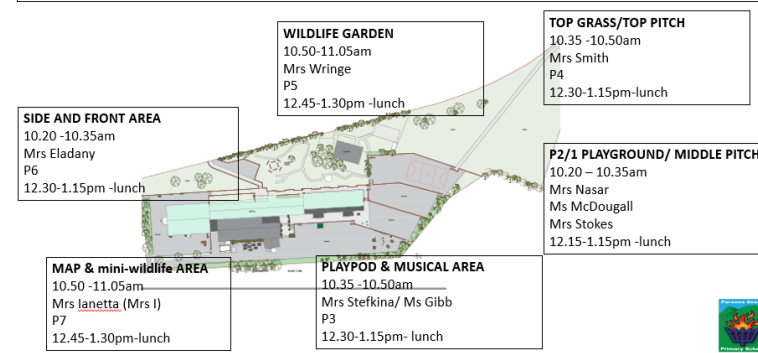

P3-7 Staggered break/lunch zones w/c 24th August 2020



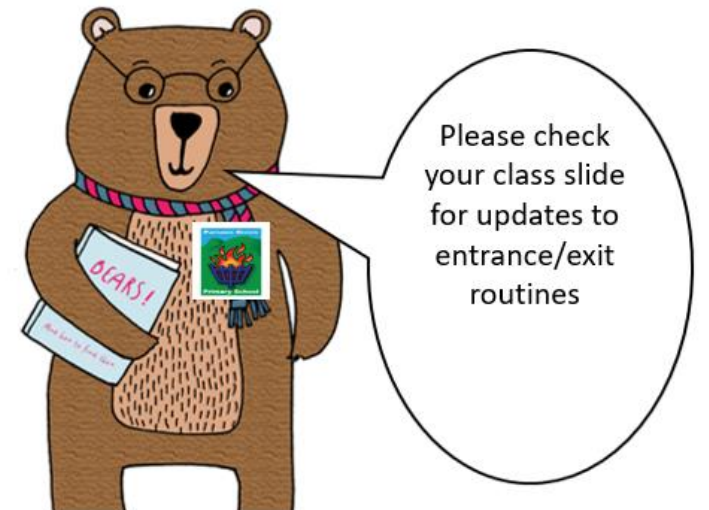
Playground rotas/ staggered breaks/lunches

Edinburgh Bear Says...





- Focus will remain on Health and Wellbeing as a priority for all learners and staff
- Recognition that some children and families may need to self-isolate/ experience more lock-down restrictions again, this can raise worries
- Underlying anxiety across the general population/media about what the future holds
- Learners need time to rebuild relationships with each other, socialise and interact with each other again, happy and positive children learn better.
- Using the 6 principles of nurture

The Six Principles Of Nurture

1. Children's learning is understood developmentally
2. The classroom offers a safe base
3. The importance of nurture for the development of wellbeing
4. Language is a vital means of communication
5. All behaviour is communication
6. The importance of transition in children's lives
